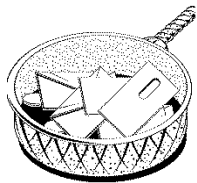

YEAR END

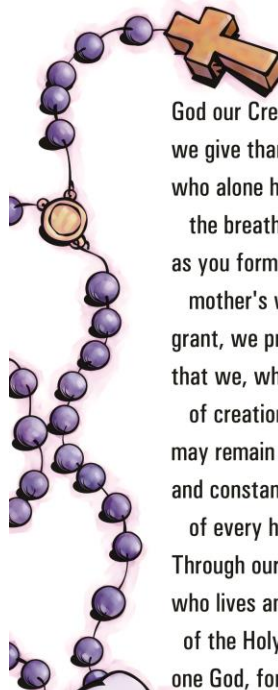
