A great big thanks to the Knights of Columbus for their continued financial contribution to help support our eye care mission trip to the Dominican Republic. We were able to examine 861 patients in 4 days, and used the funds to purchase new glasses for these patients. We were hosted by the ILAC Center in Santiago, which is affiliated with Creighton University. In addition to dispensing glasses, sunglasses and treating eye infections and irritation, we were able to diagnose and arrange surgical referrals for 79 of the patients. Surgeons from New York will be traveling to the ILAC in March to perform surgery on those patients that need additional care.
