ENCOUNTER INNOVATION

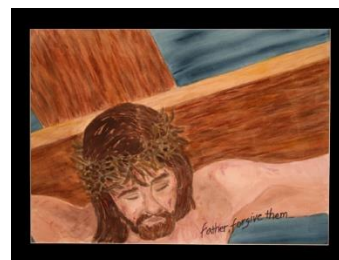
