AQUINAS FORUM

Make plans to attend The Aquinas Forum, a Catholic lecture series for inquiring minds on Tuesday, Oct. 28, 7 p.m., at Gloria Deo, 13065 W. Center Rd., in Omaha. Bill Beckman, director of the Archdiocese Office of Evangelization and Catechetics, will present “Blessed Pope Paul VI: A steady Hand in Turbulent Times.” The years from 1963 to 1978 were marked by immense change and challenge in the U. S. and throughout the world. The Church was not immune. Pope Paul VI, who was beatified by Pope Francis on Oct. 19, 2014, proved an able captain of the barque of Peter as he safely guided the holy Church through the narrows and straits of a turbulent time.
