PARISH & SCHOOL STUDY

About 275 pastors, school principals and lay leaders met November 8 to discuss preliminary findings of a Wisconsin-based consulting firm as it directs a study of Catholic parishes and elementary schools in east Omaha. Titled "Parish & School Study: Jesus, Light Our Way," the study area includes 37 parishes and 18 schools east of 72nd Street. The study began with several months of meetings with pastors, principals and lay leaders to discuss the many changes in parish and school life that have taken place over the past number of years in the study area.
