The Giving Tree will be located in our church beginning this week. Displayed on the tree will be 2-part, paper ornaments with suggested items per person. We will try to give as much detail as possible.

Once you select an ornament, please leave the bottom copy of the ornament in the box by the tree with your name on it. This tells us that the ornament has been taken and not lost or forgotten. After you have purchased your item, securely attach the top part of the ornament to the item with tape. Lastly, return the unwrapped item to the church and place it under the tree. It is very important that you do not wrap the item. Baskets will be provided near the tree. We will collect items daily and get them ready for a group wrapping party.

Ornaments will be added daily, so please re-visit the tree at a later time if ornaments are taken.
