Located at The Cloisters on the Platte, the Stations of the Cross is a 2,500 foot long walking tour comprised of 14 sculpture stations that represent Christ's trial through his burial. The Stations of the Cross will be open to the public Mondays through Wednesdays from 9am to 6pm and on Thursdays from 9am to 1pm. It is not necessary to call in advance of your visit. Groups of 20 or more should contact us a week in advance.

There is a suggested \$10 per person donation for people making The Stations of the Cross walk. A special audio tour developed for The Stations of the Cross at The Cloisters on the Platte is included with every \$10 donation. Donations support The Cloisters on the Platte and the Stations of the Cross. When you arrive, please park in the parking lot across from main gate. Shuttle service from the parking lot operates throughout hours of operation and will provide entry for our guests to the Stations of the Cross.
